Sign in and Out

Little Ribbon Candies are some of our youngest dancers. Safety is most important for them in a large facility such as Merrill Auditorium. We ask that one adult be assigned to bring them to the backstage area and sign in with our volunteer staff. Upon sign-in, you will be issued a backstage pass for pickup following performances. Security will only admit adults that have that pass after the show to maintain safety.

Girls Hair

Little Ribbon Candy's hair needs to be slicked back into a bun on the back of their heads (no bangs). Please bring 20-30 straight bobby pins to attach the hair bow.

Girls Makeup

1. Face – Matte (not shiny) foundation that matches your skin tone, and pressed powder to match.
2. Eyes – Medium brown matte eye shadow and black mascara.
3. Lips – True red lipstick. Should not have blue or purple undertones, just a real red.

Girls Costume

Dancers are asked to wear (under the provided costume) a nude, white, or light pink camisole leotard, pink ballet tights, and pink ballet slippers. Come to the theater with your leotard and tights on, there is no changing area in the rehearsal hall. Costumes are worn over leotard and tights. Earrings are not required but you may wear small rhinestone stud earrings if desired.

Boys Hair

Hair is neat and natural-looking

Boys Makeup

Light blush on cheeks, clear lip gloss

Boys Costume

Please wear a white t-shirt, white-footed tights, and white ballet shoes. Costumes are worn over t-shirt and tights.

Please remove nail polish and all other jewelry including piercings, remove eyeglasses on stage if possible. Leave valuables at home.
